





















## **News from our AWMA President**

#### AWMA Members:

I have a couple of reminders for you. The membership year started on June 1. If you haven't renewed your dues for this year, be sure to do so through Zooza.

If you have a scorebook issued for your Belgian through UScA, it is to your advantage to have it transferred to an AWMA book. As you know, UScA scorebooks are not accepted by AWDF member organizations (including the AWMA) after June 30, 2019. To change your scorebook, send your UScA scorebook and an AWMA scorebook application form to the AWMA Membership Chair. You can find the forms at

http://www.workingmalinois.org/index.php/scorebooks. It's best to do this well in advance of when you will enter a trial to avoid the rush fee required for scorebooks issued within two weeks.

We also encourage you to form an AWMA club. It is easy to do. You need three current AWMA members. Fill out the club application form and send it to your regional director along with your bylaws for approval before sending to the AWMA Secretary. If you have prior experience hosting events, you can directly apply for full membership with no affiliation trial required. Be sure to provide information on your experience with your club application. After your dues have been received, the board will vote on your application. If you already belong to a local IGP club, you can have dual affiliation with your current organization and with the AWMA. If you bring in a judge accepted by both organizations, you can hold a two day trial with the same judge officiating for each organization. For example, you could have a DVG trial on Saturday and use the same

This is also a reminder that all AWMA clubs are required to have one sanctioned event per year to remain an active club. The event could be a trial, training seminar, or other activity provided it is approved by your regional director. If you haven't already had your annual event, please schedule it as soon as possible so that you are eligible to vote at the upcoming annual meeting.

Plans are well underway for the 2019 AWMA IGP Championship to be held October 17-20 in Old Orchard Beach, Maine. Event registration is open. You can find more information at www.2019awma.com.

## Election for Regional Directors

Elections for regional directors take place this year prior to the annual meeting held at the AWMA IGP Championship. Your club delegates should be receiving a message from your regional director (Waine Singleton, Linda Guidry, or Jim Downing) about nominations for this position and the date when the election will be held. If you are interested in running for the position of regional director or assistant regional director, contact your respective regional director for instructions on what to submit. Regional directors serve on the executive board of the AWMA and oversee activities in their respective area of the country (see

http://workingmalinois.org/images/forms/regionaldirector.pdf for a description of duties and responsibilities). You do not need to be part of an AWMA club to run for the position of regional director. There is a requirement that to hold office you must have titled a dog to at least an IPO 1 (now IGP 1), VPG 1, FR 1 or MR 1 and you must be a current AWMA

#### How does one get approved to utilize an AWMA judge?

The AWMA will accept any judge from an AWDF member club who has completed a judge's program that has been reviewed and approved by the AWDF. Likewise, any IGP judge licensed by an FCI organization who is approved to judge internationally is acceptable. If there is a question about the acceptability of a specific judge, contact the AWMA Director of Judges, Glenn Stephenson.

- Contact the Judge to see if they are available for your trial dates
- Name of the Judge, Location, Date, & Titles offered are submitted to your Regional Director.
- Upon approval the regional director submits the request to the AWMA Director of Judges.
- Once the AWMA judge is approved no further action is needed

## Did you know that AWMA has a reward based policy in place for utilizing our own judges at a trial?

If your AWMA club utilizes an AWMA judge, that club will get a \$100 dollars back at the end of the year.


















**ABMC Member**
